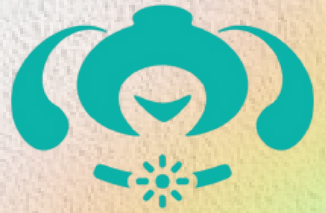


Pawgress Report: Comments
